Forms must be in the hands of the Election Committee no later than 9:00 p.m. at the February meeting of the Cayucos Citizens' Advisory Council Meeting.

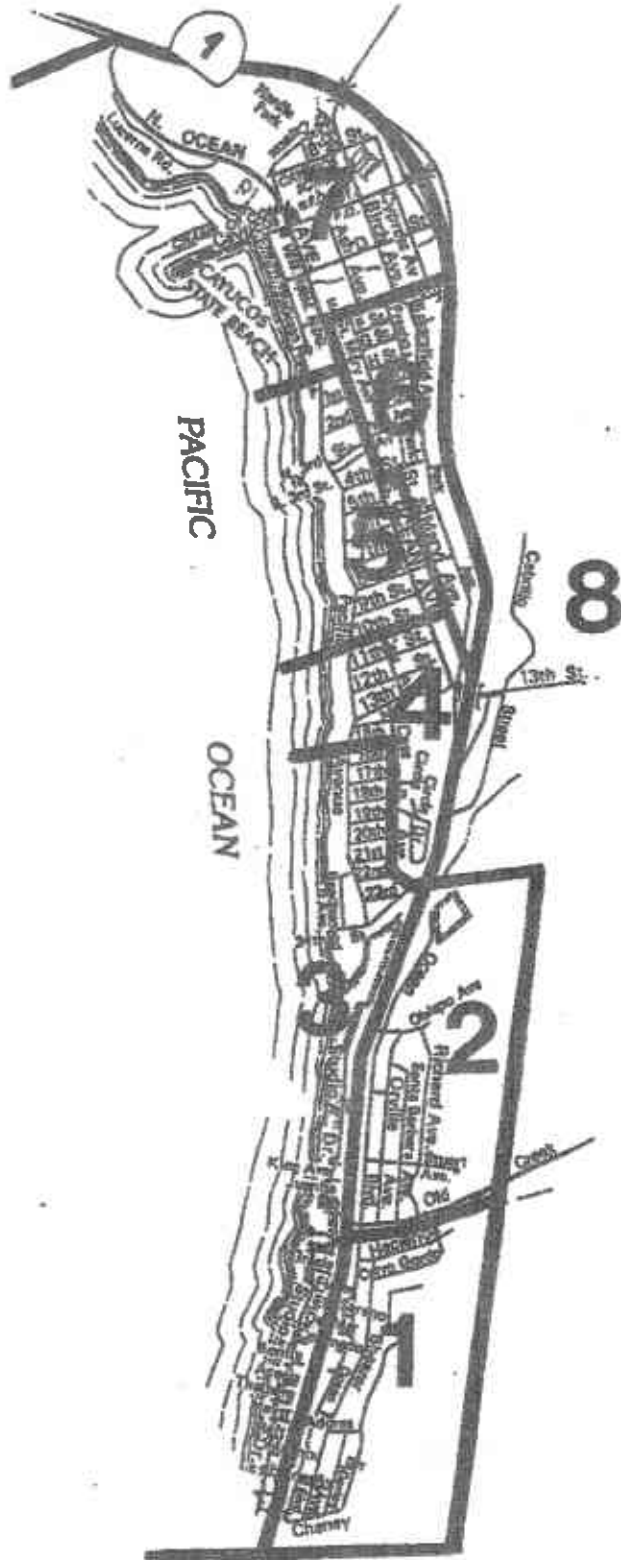

PORTION OF BYLAW'S
ARTICLE III
Election of the Council

SECTION 1: Candidates for nomination and election must have their principal and permanent residence and be registered to vote in the precinct for which they seek Council representation.

SECTION 2: Candidates may be nominated by a Council member or self-nominated. Candidates shall not be nominated prior to their consent.

SECTION 3: Nominations must be made by or during the scheduled February Council meeting prior to the election.

SECTION 4: Elections are to be held the second Tuesday in March. One polling site shall be established for election day.

SECTION 5: Those eligible to vote in the Advisory Council election must be eighteen (18) or older and must have their principal and permanent residence and be registered to vote within the precinct for which they vote.

SECTION 6: Precinct representatives shall be elected by the first and second highest number of votes cast. The alternate representative shall be elected by the third highest number of votes cast.

SECTION 7: Newly elected representatives are to be seated at the first meeting following election.
